Thrush (Yeast Infection in the Breast) 2 Breastfeeding FOR BABY1: • Treat baby's mouth with antifungal 1-4 times a day (depending on the type medicine) after every feed Do not wash it off • Continue breastfeeding even when taking the medicine

Breastfeeding Having a plugged duct is common for many women while breastfeeding A plugged duct is a small milk duct that was not properly drained The milk duct becomes inflamed and blocked You will feel a tender spot or lump in one of your breasts filled with thick milk¹ This goes away after breastfeeding There is no danger to
